## 1. Introduction

## 1.1. Purpose

The purpose of this document is to define the minimum requirements for registration to become a supplier on whole of government Telecommunications Purchasing Arrangements (TPA).

The document allows for suppliers to register their interest at any time by completing the Response Schedules contained in this form and submitting the completed information to the Contract Authority via <u>email</u> [tpa@customerservice.nsw.gov.au]

### **1.2. Scope**

The scope of this document is to describe the required mandatory evaluation criteria, as a minimum for suppliers to be considered for registration to Contract 2210. This document does not describe further mandatory stages that a supplier must pass through to ultimately become a TPA panel member.

This document includes 2 Key Response Schedules (Schedule 1: Supplier Details and Schedule 2: Mandatory Evaluation) in which the supplier is required to complete in full, including all requested supporting documentation, and return to the Contract Authority.

## 2. Service Provider Registration Details

## 2.1. Mandatory Evaluation Criteria

Suppliers must demonstrate that they meet the following mandatory requirements in respect of the following evaluation criteria:

- Compliance with applicable NSW Procurement policies, legislation and standards
- Australian Licensed Carrier or Carriage Service Provider
- NSW Based Service Delivery
- Advanced pre-qualified supplier under the ICT Service Scheme
- Service Tower Expression of Interest
- Intention to Submit
- Terms and Conditions under TPA Additional Conditions

Details of the requirements for these mandatory criteria are set out below.



## 2.1.1 Compliance with applicable NSW Procurement policies, legislations and standards

The Supplier must indicate if they comply with applicable NSW Procurement policies, legislations and standards. These policies and legislations includes compliance with the NSW Government Procurement Policy, Supplier Code of Conduct, NSW Work Health and Safety Regulation 2017, NSW Workplace Injury Management and Workers Compensation Act 1998 and the Modern Slavery Act 2018.

#### 2.1.2 Licensed Carrier or Carriage Service Provider

The Supplier must hold a current Carrier Licensee, or be a Carriage Service Provider, under the *Telecommunications Act 1997* (Cth).

#### 2.1.3 NSW Based Service Delivery

The Supplier (or at least one of its nominated subcontractors) must have service delivery operations (not just sales operations or a field office) in Australia.

#### 2.1.4 ICT Service Scheme (SCM0020) Pre-qualification

As a minimum, the Supplier must be either pre-qualified as an advanced supplier under the ICT Services Scheme (SCM0020) or be in the process of becoming pre-qualified as an advanced supplier under the ICT Services Scheme.

Prior to becoming a panel member, the supplier must be pre-qualified as an advanced supplier under the ICT Services Scheme (SCM0020).

#### 2.1.5 Service Tower Expression of Interest

The Supplier must apply for selection as a Service Provider for at least one of the five service towers and one of three locations in accordance with the request for Expression of Interest. These Service Towers include Fixed Data, Internet, Voice, Network Applications and Mobiles. Location Category includes Metropolitan, Regional and Remote.

#### 2.1.6 Intention to Submit

The Supplier must indicate the service types which the supplier may wish to supply if approved on the TPA panel. These service types include Fixed Data, Internet, Voice, Network Applications and Mobiles.

#### 2.1.7 Terms and Conditions under TPA Additional Conditions

The Supplier must provide compliance response to each terms and conditions listed in the Part C – TPA Additional Conditions document. These additional conditions relates to Head Agreement, Formation, Membership and Term of Panel, Non-Exclusive Panel, Non Obligation to Purchase, Consequences of Removal or Dissolution, Services and Pricing, Pricing, Annual Price Review, Benchmarking, Reporting, Confidential Information, Customer Contract, Dictionary and other.
