



The whole of life contract value should be used for when calculating the procurement value.

Whole of life contract value = (Initial contract term) + (any extension options)

The below thresholds apply for when:

- An agency is unaccredited; or
- Where an accredited agency's internal quote thresholds are silent on minimum quotes required for ICT procurements

	Over \$250 000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For accredited NSW Government agencies follow the agency's policies If internal policies are silent, follow the decision tree
Telco Purchasing Agreement (TPA) (PBD-2019-02-Telecommunications Procurement applies)	Up to \$100 000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Obtain minimum one (1) written quote
	Over \$100 000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Buy through the Telecommunications Purchasing Arrangements (Contract 2210). Seek quotes from at least three (3) providers for telecommunications services at contract expiry, unless purchasing the lowest price offer through Contract 2210
